

The Willits' are also the creators of the popular That Catholic Show video series, a series of amazingly original short and fun videos that teach different elements about the Catholic Church.


For over 4 years, Greg and Jennifer hosted "The Catholics Next Door," daily on SiriusXM's The Catholic Channel.


Greg and Jennifer live in the Atlanta, Georgia area and are the parents of four boys and a daughter.


The prayers on the next page come from the 1949 New Catholic Edition of the Holy Bible, published by the Catholic Book Publishing Company of New York.
